5 Litter

KCC had received correspondence about the amount of litter disfiguring certain areas.
Agreed to write to the Co-op to ask them what they can do to reduce litter near the shop. MM/RL

Agreed to write to Dot Ferguson to ask whether the Criminal Justice Service are able to help MM/RL
Agreed to write to Network Rail to see what they can do to clear litter on their land MM/RL

Noted that both Banavie School and Kilmallie Playgroup have litter-awareness projects coming up.

6 Any other business

- 6.01 MM/JM reported on Scottish Canals' Customer Forum event, noting proposal to develop 'glamping' pods on east side of Banavie basin. Drop-in consultations are apparently planned for Banavie and Gairloch in coming weeks.

- 6.02 News greatly welcomed from AH that the LAD bus now has Sect 22 license and can stop to pick up passengers.
- 6.03 Info received from Dog Warden Fiona Docherty – if people report dog fouling to them, and can identify where and when for regular offences, then the Dog Warden has powers to watch, wait and issue on-the-spot £40 penalty notices.
- 6.04 Agreed to invite WRVS and Red Cross to a future meeting. SSE may also ask to come and speak. MM/CH
- 6.05 Noted that Marine Harvest have sponsored a defibrillator at Glenfinnan, located in an external box so not needing premises to accommodate one.
- 6.06 Noted that signposts prohibiting footpath access at Moy Bridge may contravene access rights. AH agreed to look into it. AH
- 6.07 The proposed 'Way to the West' long distance footpath, which will route through Kilmallie, was welcomed.
