### 1. Approval of previous minutes

The minutes of the remote meeting on 22 June 2020 were approved.

### 2. Declarations of interest

### 3. Establishment of a liaison group to address complaints of noise and pollution from Annat

At the previous meeting it had been recommended that a liaison group be established to try and address any issues affecting the community from industrial operations at Annat. It was agreed that such a group would need formal, regular meetings that were independently chaired and minuted. The group should involve all the operators at Annat, Planning, Environmental Health, SEPA, Kilmallie CC, Ardgour CC and members of the community. It was noted that the Banavie Quarry Liaison group had generally worked well but that this had been established as a planning condition. It would not be possible to use a planning condition to establish a group at Annat because all the operators were working under different planning permissions. It was agreed to write to Dot Ferguson to request engagement from Highland Council to establish an appropriate group.

### 4. Application 20/02154/FUL for lateral extension to Banavie Quarry and extension of operational lifespan to 2045

KCC has been represented on the liaison group for Banavie Quarry and there had also been a consultation event about the application. It was agreed that the relocation of the coating plant to Carr's Corner would be beneficial to residents by removing one of the main sources of noise and the need for overnight working. The number of truck movements on the access road were likely to remain the same as currently. A planning condition of the previous application had been the restoration of the back face of the quarry, which had not yet happened because of the steepness of the face. A restoration plan was included in the current application. It was agreed that KCC should submit comments highlighting the need to ensure that this restoration did actually take place as proposed.
